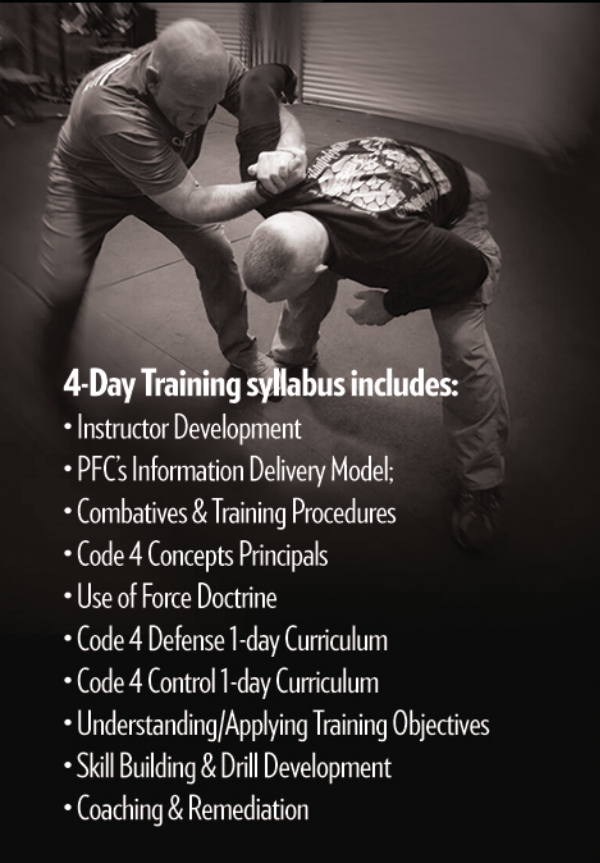


CODE 4 TACTICS INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION

Open to law enforcement, Department of Defense, government agencies, eligible government contractors, security instructors, and approved civilian trainers

Pre-requisite: Prior defensive tactics or martial arts training required.
